Summer Reading Assignment

The common summer reading book (**REQUIRED** for all students) for HHS AP Language is *Fist Stick Knife Gun* by Geoffrey Canada. Read the book and complete a journal entry for each chapter, including the Preface. As the book has 25 chapters, you will have 26 entries. You may type or handwrite the entries. Be prepared to turn in the assignment on the first day of class.

For each journal entry, **state the main argument** in *one complex or complex/compound-complex sentence* in the left hand column. In the right hand column, write **one quote** from the chapter, including the page number, and **explain** how the quote supports the main argument.

Earlier in the chapter, he describes in detail the working conditions in the meat plants, and provides anecdotal data about how companies have turned to undocumented workers because they are less expensive and less likely to speak out. Later in the chapter, he provides data to support his claim that the OSHA does not consistently enforce governmental regulations.
